Dana Hall (jazz studies and ethnomusicology) recently led a quartet in a special performance at the Fulton Street Collective, as part of their monthly *Jazz Record Art Collective Jazz Series*. His ensemble performed, in its entirety, the classic recording Of Course, Of Course by saxophonist and flutist Charles Lloyd. Last week, Professor Hall performed a four-night engagement at the Jazz Showcase with New York-based saxophonist Adam Larson and his quintet, featuring saxophonist John Wojciechowski, in preparation for a new recording later this year. Finally, Professor Hall's ensemble Black Fire, currently in its tenth month of Tuesday evening performances at Andy's Jazz Club, has been asked to extend their engagement for the remainder of 2014.

Janet Sung (violin) performed Mendelssohn's Violin Concerto in a pair of concerts with the Las Cruces Symphony Orchestra in New Mexico. She also gave several masterclasses. She was also a guest artist with the Finger Lakes Chamber Ensemble performing concerts in Ithaca, NY.
