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## BIOGRAPHIES

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A native of Dayton, OH, saxophonist **Scott Burns** has been a fixture on the Chicago jazz scene for over two decades, as well as an in-demand educator. He received his Bachelor of Music degree from the University of Cincinnati College-Conservatory of Music, and his Master of Music degree from DePaul University, both in Jazz Studies.

Mr. Burns is frequently heard performing as a leader of his own groups and as a sideman in leading jazz venues, concert halls, and festivals. He has performed alongside several international jazz artists, including McCoy Tyner, Ahmad Jamal, Clark Terry, Jimmy Heath, Charles McPherson, Kenny Barron, Benny Green, Ira Sullivan, Joe Henderson, Tom Harrell, Joe Lovano, Bob Mintzer, Kenny Werner, Randy Brecker, John Faddis, Joshua Redman, Eric Alexander, Nicholas Payton, Roy Hargrove, David Hazeltine, Wycliffe Gordon, Marquis Hill, Bobby Broom, Peter Erskine, Jeff Hamilton, Harold Jones, Freddie Cole, René Marie, Lou Rawls, Kurt Elling, Tony Bennett and Harry Connick Jr. Mr. Burns has performed across the nation at many major festivals and venues including the JVC Jazz Fest, the Newport Jazz Fest, the Chicago Jazz Festival, Chicago Symphony Center, Jay Pritzker Pavilion, Ravinia Festival, and the Kennedy Center in Washington D.C. He has been a member of the Chicago Jazz Orchestra since 2006. He has also performed with many symphony and opera orchestras, including the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, Chicago Philharmonic Society, Lyric Opera Orchestra, Florentine Opera Company, Chicago Opera Theater, Cincinnati Pops Orchestra, and Ravinia Festival Orchestra. Mr. Burns has performed on over 30 albums and numerous other recording projects. His latest CD, *Passages*, released on Origin Records and featuring all original compositions, has received critical acclaim and airtime across the nation.

Mr. Burns is also a dedicated educator to students of all levels. He joined the faculty of the DePaul School of Music in 2014, becoming a full-time faculty member in 2021. He taught previously at Loyola University Chicago, North Park University, and Columbia College Chicago. Since 2013 he has been a jazz faculty member at Birch Creek Music Performance Center's Summer Music Academy in Egg Harbor, WI. He has also worked with students in the Thelonious Monk Jazz Institute's Chicago chapter, the Northwestern University High School Music Institute, the Milwaukee Jazz Institute, and the Chicago Jazz Institute. Mr. Burns has been a guest clinician, adjudicator and performer at numerous high school jazz festivals, ILMEA district festivals, colleges and universities in Chicago and the Midwest.

**Accessibility:** HPC is dedicated to providing access for all patrons. We ask that you please contact the HPC Box Office at least two weeks prior to your performance date to request accessibility services.

**Cameras and Recorders:** The taking of photographs or the recording of concerts held at HPC is strictly prohibited. By attending this concert, you consent to be photographed, filmed and/or otherwise recorded.
